The 4x4 Tour

Terrain: Main Road and Off-road tracks

Duration: Full Island Tour - 6 ½ hours

Lunch: Inclusive

Cost: Minimum Charge of £150 for 1-3 persons .

Aarons Adventures Tours offers visitors the opportunity to see and learn about the islands rich history and natural beauty via an all day off road tour. The tour starts in Jamestown making your way through to Longwood via Sea View and Gordon's post areas, en-route are many interesting historical, natural and local points of interest. Once in Longwood you will stop at Deadwood Plain which was the camp site of Boer prisoners of war during the Anglo Boer War of 1900-1902. Driving on to Flagstaff offers magnificent panoramic views of the island. En-route to Levelwood is the Millenium forest and the St Helena Airport within the rugged landscapes of Prosperous Plain. At Levelwood is the Bellstone a large rock that when struck rings like a bell. Driving through the luscious interior of Sandy Bay the next stop is Sandy Bay beach at the coast with the vast contrasting volcanic rock formations. The tour drives through the heartland of the island and onto the Western side to Blue Hill providing scenes of green rolling country sides and spectacular ocean views.

Terrain: Main Road

Duration: Full Island Tour – 5 Hours

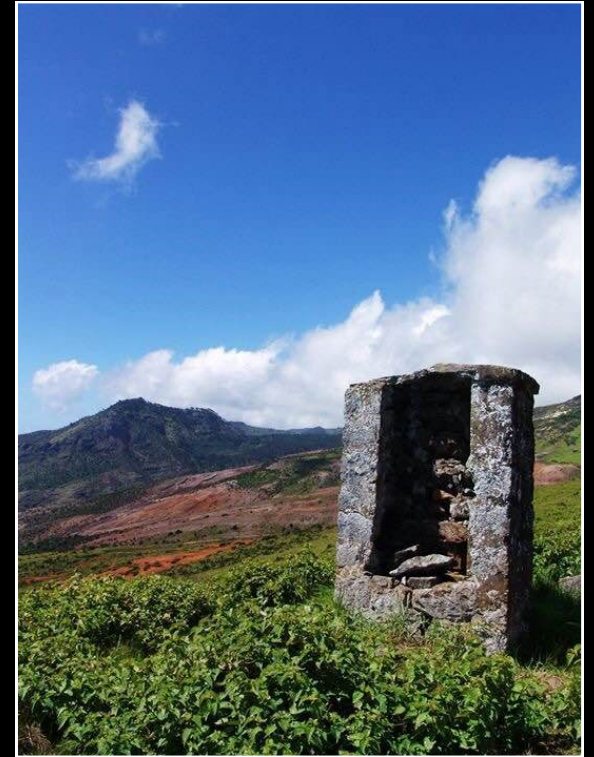

The Island tour offers visitors an Island wide tour, which includes the main historical sites, local points of interest and contrasting scenic views including Deadwood Plain, the Millenium Forest, Sandy bay and sandy Bay beach, Blue Hill, St Pauls Cathedral, The Boer War Cemetery, the grounds of Plantation house, High Knoll Fort and fortifications at Ladder Hill, and Jacobs Ladder.



THE NAPOLEONIC STORY TOUR

Terrain: Main Road for driving portions of tour. Includes a short walk to Napoleons Tomb (approx. 1km return).

Duration: Approx 5 hours

Lunch: Inclusive

Cost: Minimum Charge of £180 for 1-3 persons thereafter £60 per person. (Napoleonic Site tickets and lunch included in cost)

Availability: Monday and Friday only.

The Napoleonic tour allows you to visit the Briars Pavilion, Longwood House and the Tomb, (entails a 1km return walk to the Tomb in Sane Valley). Napoleon Bonaparte spent six years exiled on St Helena from 1815 to his death in 1821. The three properties are owned by the French government, and Longwood House is one of the best Napoleonic museums in the world, with original furniture and artefacts.



GUIDED WALKS

Aarons Adventure Tours has a selection of the islands most popular hikes and walks that we offer guided services. During our guided walks and hikes, clients are also informed of the local history and information on the flora and fauna within the particular areas. Walks on St Helena are rated by difficulty and terrain however this should not be underestimated and persons should consider their fitness and ability levels before booking.

Cost: Minimum charge of £75 up to three persons thereafter £35 per person
